Since COP21 in 2015 Djibouti has made a strong commitment to energy transition. Today, our country generates around 80% of its energy from renewable sources – thanks mainly to the interconnection with Ethiopia and the development of the wind farm. Under the leadership of Yonis Ali Guedi, minister of energy since 2017, the country is increasing its solar and wind power projects. The aim is to reduce its energy dependence, limit.
